By the sign of the Cross, deliver us from our enemies, O our God. *1.* I will love thee, O Lord, my strength: the Lord is my firmament, my refuge, and my deliverer. *2.* My God is my helper, and in him will I put my trust; my protector and the horn of my salvation, and my support. *3.* Praising I will call upon the Lord: and I shall be saved from my enemies. *4.* He delivered me from my strongest enemies, and from them that hated me: for they were too strong for me. *5.* I will pursue after my enemies, and overtake them: and I will not turn again till they are consumed. *6.* I will break them, and they shall not be able to stand: they shall fall under my feet. *7.* And thou hast made my enemies turn their back upon me, and hast destroyed them that hated me. *8.* O God, who avengest me, and subduest the people under me, my deliverer from my enemies. *9.* And thou wilt lift me up above them that rise up against me: from the unjust man thou wilt deliver me. *10.* Therefore will I give glory to thee, O Lord, among the nations, and I will sing a psalm to thy name.
